



COVID-19 Protocol Update February 2022

On June 28, 2021, Governor Tom Wolf lifted the mask mandate and other COVID-19 restrictions. As we (Kenbrook Bible Camp) continue to monitor the changing guidance and plan for summer camp 2022 and welcoming back many guest groups, we have become a “mask-friendly” camp and retreat center.

We wish to show God’s love, compassion and respect to those who may want to continue wearing a mask as well as to those who do not want to wear a mask.

We do continue to utilize thorough cleaning procedures in all camp and retreat buildings. We do ask all campers and guests to utilize good hand-washing and hygiene practices and take advantage of hand sanitizing stations throughout the property. We ask that anyone experiencing flu/COVID-like symptoms remain home and not come to camp.

For summer camp this year, we will operate camp on as much a normal process as possible. We will continue to do temperature screenings and ask COVID screening questions at check-in. As noted above, we will be a mask-friendly camp and will not be requiring masks to be worn inside or outside but will respect and honor those who do wish to wear them.

As has been the practice through the entire pandemic; we will continue to monitor the COVID landscape as well as state guidance and make adjustments as needed.
